PROJECT IDENTIFICATION:

DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT PARKING IMPROVEMENTS – MISCELLANEOUS TRAFFIC STRIPING PROJECT

PROPOSAL FORM

The purpose of this Request For Quotes (RFQ) is to obtain costs for the installation of approximately 7,000 linear feet of epoxy resin traffic striping, 10 units of traffic markings for handicap parking, 100 square feet of regulatory and warning signs, and associated work.

The work must conform to all State, County and Local regulations and codes, and the specifications included in this Request for Proposal (RFP).

The undersigned firm proposes to provide all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct the various components of the work in accordance with the drawings and/or specifications.

The undersigned shall also file evidence of insurance with Owner and Engineer before commencing work. Certificates provided shall include, but not be limited to, Workman's Compensation, Comprehensive General Liability, naming the Owner and Engineer as co-insured principals.

Contractors submitting proposals should familiarize themselves with the site and proposed work. All work shall be in accordance with the NJDOT Standard Specifications - 2007 as amended herein.

Proposals shall be submitted no later than the date and time noted in the Notice of Request For Quotes. Pricing and other information requested shall be filled in completely and this entire proposal package shall be submitted intact.

Bidders shall comply with all requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law and with the Public Works Contractor Registration Act, latest revisions. Bidders and subcontractors shall possess a valid Public Works Contractor Registration Certificate at the time of the bid.

Bidders shall submit, **with the bid package**, proof of business registration in the form of a copy of their Business Registration Certificate from the New Jersey Division of Revenue.

Bidders shall comply with N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 latest revision, regarding Business Registration with the New Jersey Division of Revenue.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et seq.) and Affirmative Action (N.J.A.C. 17:27) and with the disclosure provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.13. The successful bidder shall be required to comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act, Chapter 150 of the Laws of 1963, effective January 1, 1964.

During the performance of this contract the Contractor agrees to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27), all requirements of the State of New Jersey Worker Health and Safety Act (N.J.A.C. 12:110 et seq.) as amended and the United States Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) (29 CFR 1910), as amended with regard to worker and jobsite safety.
